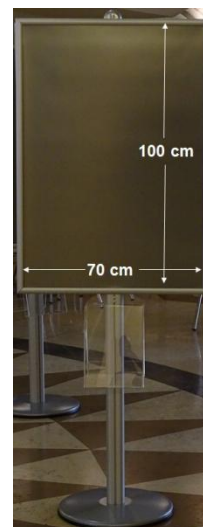


POSTER PRESENTATION RULES

Authors need to be aware of the following guidelines regarding their poster presentation:

I. PREPARATION

- Poster size - **B1 (70x100cm)**.
- Poster orientation - **Portrait**.
- Normal text - **no smaller than 20 pt**.
- Text in plots and figures - should also be **at least 20 pt**.
- **Good poster length - 1000 words**.
- Make sure the **font size is large enough to read** people standing from five feet away.
- Use **section headings** to orient the viewer.
- Use **serif fonts** for the **main text** (ex. Times).
- Use **sans-serif fonts** for **titles and headings** (ex. Helvetica, Arial).
- The poster is not required to fill the entire poster working area.



II. DELIVERY

- **Upon completing the poster** - the corresponding author should send an electronic copy (picture or pdf file) of the poster to the Congress Team at the 'Submit Presentation' button, at the **latest by the 15th of May**.
- **Upon arriving at the congress** - the corresponding author should deliver a **physical copy** of the poster to the **Congress Team** at the **Info Desk** for display in the poster exhibition area.

III. PRESENTATION

A). **Display** - before the start day of each session, all delivered posters will be displayed by the congress team in the designated poster exhibition area.

- *Authors can see at what time slot (day and session) their poster presentation is scheduled, by checking the Congress Poster Program.*
- *To avoid damage to the poster and poster holders, **we ask that participants DO NOT place their posters up themselves, and instead let the congress team set them up.***

B). **Evaluation** - each poster will be evaluated by the Congress Poster Evaluation Committee, which will grade the posters by examining the quality of the presented information, the required technicalities in preparation, and the overall aesthetic value and presentation of the poster.

- *The presenter of the poster should be present next to their poster when the evaluation is conducted.*

C). **Awards** - following the evaluation of all posters, the 3 best posters selected by the congress evaluation committee will be announced by the congress president at the closing ceremony of the congress.

- *Each winner will receive an award for their inclusion in the list of winning posters.*
